"Surreal Objects"

Surrealism is a cultural movement that began in the early 1920s, and is best known for its visual artworks and writings. Surrealist works feature the element of surprise, unexpected juxtapositions and non sequitur.

For your assignment, the challenge is to combine two objects (including people & animals) in an unexpected way and to draw or paint this combination in such a way that the two work together seamlessly. Consider what surprising connection you can find between your two objects. Connections could be playful or profound! While you may source your imagery from life, photographs, or your imagination, the design must be your own, original idea. Your final work should be fully rendered (more than a loose sketch!) Expect to dedicate at least an hour or more to this drawing.
